<b>How were those who are undecided handled?</b>	<i>Undecideds were asked a 'squeeze' question to identify which way they were leaning. Those still unsure were excluded from the final valid results</i>
<b>How was two-party preferred calculated?</b>	<i>Respondent allocated preferences. Respondents were offered a chance to say that they would not preference either Liberal/National or Labor</i>
