How were those who are undecided handled?	Undecideds were asked a 'squeeze' question to identify which way they were leaning. Those still unsure were excluded from the final valid results
How was two-party preferred calculated?	Respondent allocated preferences. Respondents were offered a chance to say that they would not preference either Liberal/National or Labor
